- ✓ Town established a Substance Abuse Prevention Department and we MOVED to 15 Pleasant Street with the Rec. Department.
- ✓ Implemented 2nd grade medication safety curriculum at all 5 elementary schools in both in person and virtual formats.
- ✓ Hosted 2 undergrad interns from Bridgewater to support collaborations with OMS and Stoughton Recreation.
- ✓ Implemented Stoughton Youth Leadership Institute with our 10th MA Promise Fellowship.
- ✓ Implemented Youth Health Pulse Survey to all 6-12 graders, March 2021. Data is being utilized for OMS and SHS school improvement plans.
- ✓ Submitted competitive grant application for Early Childhood Prevention (waiting on results).
- ✓ Provided Edventi prevention curriculum to SHS.
- ✓ Received MA DPH MassCall3 grant for FY'22 to collaborate with Easton, Avon and Norwood on regional youth prevention strategies.
- ✓ Offered multiple virtual workshops for parents on topics including: mental health, opiate abuse prevention, teen marijuana use (in collaboration with Stoughton Police and SYC)
- ✓ Provided Drug Take Back event in conjunction with Fall Hazardous Waste Day.
