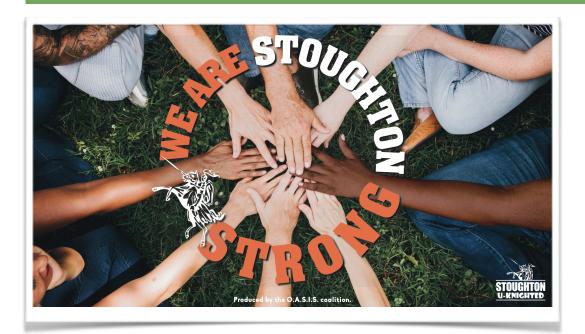
2020 Stoughton High Survey Key Findings Report

Summary of significant findings about Alcohol, Vaping and Marijuana use in Stoughton



Most Stoughton youth are making good decisions and have healthy, protective beliefs about alcohol, tobacco and other drugs.



Most Stoughton youth over-estimate the prevalence of alcohol, tobacco and other drug use among their peers, which puts them at greater risk for using these substances themselves.

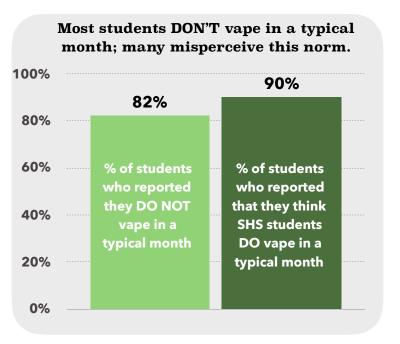


Survey Background

The results presented in this report are based on the February 2020 Stoughton Positive **Community Norms** Survey. These results are based on 786 surveys of 9-12 grade Stoughton Students. Surveys were anonymous and participation was voluntary. The data was analyzed by an independent evaluator and is only presented in aggregate.



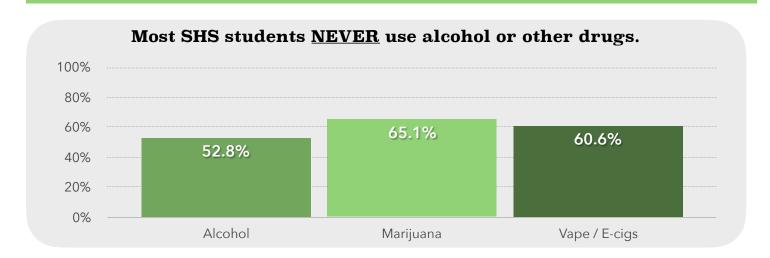
Student Behaviors



Most SHS students DO NOT use alcohol or other drugs in a typical month.

Marijuana	80%	84%
Vape or E-Cigs	82%	90%

Most SHS families make choices that support student healthy behaviors.

It is important to take classes and schoolwork seriously. (92%)

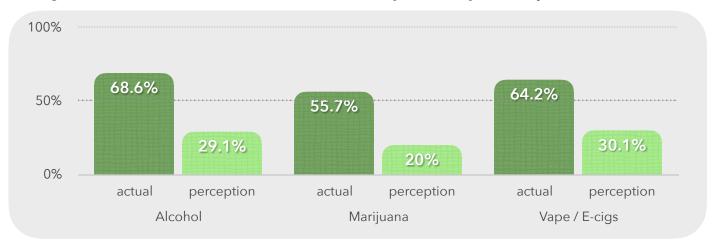
It is important to be physically active. (90%)

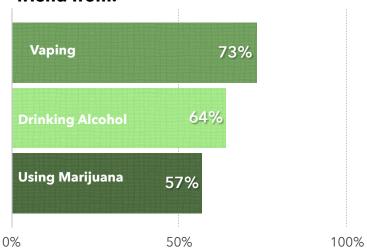
Student Attitudes

Most SHS students think it is never a good thing for people their age to use alcohol, marijuana or e-cigs. However, most SHS students believe that only a minority of their peers feel the same.



Substance	% of SHS that believe their parent or guardian thinks it is WRONG to use the following:
Alcohol	80.4%
Marijuana	84.6%
Vape or E-Cigs	88.2%
Cigarettes	77.8%
RX Drugs	94.1%
